BELONGING AT ST THOMAS' CHURCH There are lots of great things about being part of a big church like St Thomas', but sometimes it can be hard to feel like you belong or are known in a large church. We really want to help you feel part of the St Thomas' church family – and for that, we need to have up to date contact details for you. There are two parts to this.

The first, and most important part, is that we would love you to sign up to **ChurchSuite**, which is our online church membership network. By joining ChurchSuite, you can update your personal details, use your privacy settings to decide what other church members can see, connect with other church members, easily update rotas, view the church calendar, and find out about and book onto all the latest exciting church events. This also enables the church to keep you informed of news, through occasional e-mails.

The second part is joining the **Electoral Roll**. The Electoral Roll is the official membership list for St T's and it is open to those who are baptised and over 16 years of age. Membership of the Electoral Roll entitles you to stand for election to the PCC, and vote at the annual church meeting.

We are required by the Church of England to renew the Electoral Roll once every 6 years, which means that anyone who wants to be on the Electoral Roll needs to (re)apply for membership before 7th April, as no names can be carried over.

It's actually pretty simple to do this. If you are already on Church Suite, you'll have received an email containing a link to an online form, to join or re-join the Electoral Roll. At the same time, you can check and update the details we hold for you on Church Suite.

If you're not yet on Church Suite, or didn't receive the email, there is a link on the home page of the church website (www.st.tees.org.uk) to the online form, or there is a paper copy of the Electoral Roll form on the welcome desk.

Either way, please return your completed form to the church office by 7th April.
